

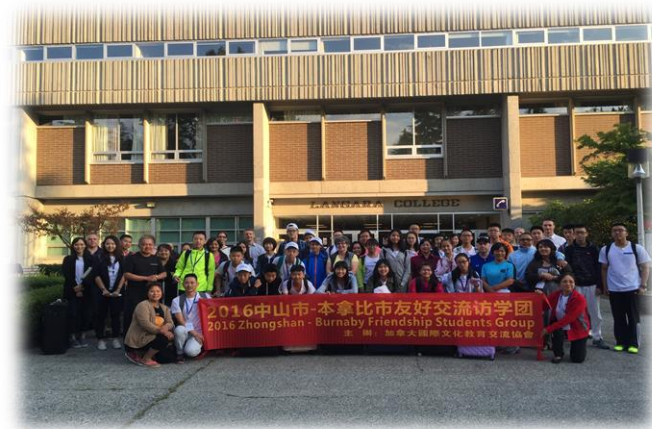


Canada Global Culture & Education Association (CGCEA) is a non-profit, non-political, independent association incorporated in British Columbia, Canada. The organization was established with the intention to: 1. facilitate communication between Canada and the world in cultural and educational areas; 2. promote mutual understanding between Canadian education institutions with the world; 3. provide accessible international resources and platforms for Canadian teachers, students and schools. After years of endeavor, Canada Federal, Provincial and Municipal Government, including MP, MLA, Ministry of Education of BC, Ministry of Advanced Education of BC and various school boards have accredited CGCEA and its work.

## 1. Inbound exchange activities

CGCEA has run short-term and long-term international inbound student exchange programs for 5 years. The organization hosts about 400 students coming for summer and winter short-term programs and about 20 students for graduation programs each year. CGCEA maintains good relationships with over 10 school districts over British Columbia.

## 2. Outbound exchange activities

In the summer of 2016, CGCEA organized the first Culture & Education Summer Program in Guangzhou, China. This 5-week BC Curriculum Summer Program involved 80 Canadian high school students, post-secondary students and graduates, public school teachers and counsellors, and retired principals, from all over BC. Sponsored by CGCEA, the program is free for all Canadian participants except for China visa and travel insurance.



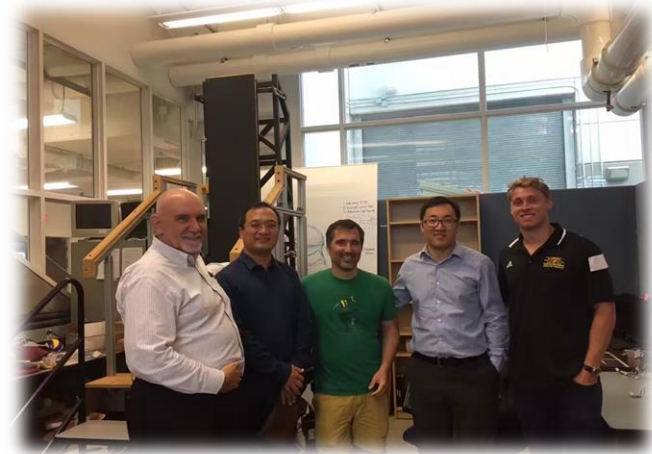
### **3. Online English speaking courses**

With its education resources in Canada, CGCEA provides professional and interactive online English speaking courses to schools in China. It serves as the best solution to many schools' concern about finding qualified foreign ESL teachers in China. The courses involve many interactive activities and group discussions with an assistant teacher on site.



#### **4. Universities and faculties collaboration**

One of the roles and objectives of CGCEA is to develop a series of distinct research and education collaboration between post-secondary education institutions in Canada and China. CGCEA assists universities and faculties with developing and expanding international networks, e.g. developing research partnership, building cooperative research labs, establishing cooperative education institutions, delivering joint courses and programs, etc.



## 5. Teacher professional development programs

CGCEA maintains long-term relationships with various Canada education institutions to collaboratively provide professional development programs to teachers, principals, staff, and teachers-to-be from China. Each program is customized to meet different needs of various education bureau and schools.



## 6. China delegates visits

With its large connection network in different parts of China, including Guangdong, Liaoning, Yunnan and Shandong, CGCEA hosted many visits and meetings for officials and delegates from China in Canada. The destinations include the Ministry of Education, city councils, school boards, etc.
